

Supporting Pupils' Literacy : TA Package

The **Supporting Pupils' Literacy** scheme consists of many interventions, drawing together techniques and resources to allow schools to recognise issues with pupils' literacy skills and to then create a framework to address the problems.

The **TA Package** works by recognising that TAs have such an incredibly important role in schools, supporting many SEN and disadvantaged pupils, and harnesses it as a valuable resource.

How can TA support be directed to improving the literacy skills of the pupils they work with ?

The *Supporting Pupils' Literacy : TA Package* is delivered in 3 distinct sessions and has been designed to allow delivery as

- a. 1 full day session
- b. 2 half day sessions
- c. 3 twilight sessions

to allow maximum flexibility to accommodate school preferences/requirements.
